

Eagle Pride Auxiliaries (Majorettes and Color Guard)

“What to Wear” Info Sheet

2023-2024

For Practices

For Tuesday and Thursday practices, Auxiliaries will be wearing section shirts, predetermined by the staff, with school appropriate athletic bottoms.

- Tops: Tuesday shirts will be assigned by the instructors at the beginning of each month. Thursdays will always be a white section shirt. The necessary students should wear a sports bra only, and no bra straps are to be showing at any time.
- Bottoms: School-appropriate athletic bottoms.
- Shoes: Athletic shoes or guard/majorette shoes.
- Hair: Hair is to be pulled back in a ponytail or bun as to not interfere with your equipment and maneuvers.

For Games – Make-up

Make-up is required for performances and must be purchased on your own before August 2023.

- Foundation: choose to match your skin tone. *Suggestion- Super Stay Full Coverage (Maybelline)*
- Lipstick: Voyager - Maybelline
- Eye Shadow: any shimmer white / beige and tan in the crease of eye lids
- Blush: pink
- Mascara: Black
- Light Eyeliner: Black

For Games – Hair

Hair will be naturally-occurring colors only, as stated in the Personal Grooming and Appearance Policy.

Hairstyle 1: A Middle part with a low bun hairstyle will be used for all games, MPA, Troy, Rose Parade, and other major performances. (See photo 1.)

- How to: 1. Part center of hair. 2. Put hair in a ponytail. 3. Wrap the hair into a bun.
- Tools required: Pony tail holders, Bun pins, hair net (if you have shorter hair), hairspray.

Hairstyle 2: A Half-up, Half-down hairstyle will be used for Homecoming, Sounds of the Stadium, and the Niceville Christmas Parade. (See Photo 2.)

- How to: 1. Curl hair. 2. Pull half the hair up in a nice clean ponytail holder with

black ribbon (these will be provided to you). 3. Hairspray any loose hairs.

For Games – Jewelry

- Earrings: only **one** piercing per ears during any NHS Eagle Pride activities and events. You will be given auxiliary earrings, which are the only pairs of earrings allowed.
- No rings, necklaces, or bracelets in uniforms at any time.

For Games – Nail Polish

Natural colors are the only permitted colors in uniform. You will be required to remove polish before performing with the Eagle Pride if you have a non-natural color nail polish on.

Equipment to be purchased on your own before Eagle Pride Pre-Camp.

- Guard: Practice Flags
- Guard: black and white tape for your equipment
- Majorettes: 3 Starline lite 7/16 batons
- Majorettes: black grip tape
- Majorettes - Black Nancy boots and Pulse Tan Jazz Shoes

Uniforms (sometimes referred to as “Costumes”)

Summer uniforms are worn during the earlier parts of the season to combat the hotter weather.

- Majorette Summer Uniforms: Black dress with N logo, tan jazz shoes.
- Color Guard Summer Uniforms: Black Guard Polo, guard black skirts/shorts, black guard shoes.

Auxiliaries will switch into “Full Uniform” part-way through the season, determined by the Director of Bands.

- Guard “Full Uniform:” NHS Guard Uniform, black pants, black socks, black guard shoes.
- Majorettes “Full Uniform:” NHS Majorette Uniform, tan tights, Tank Pulse jazz shoes, black boots.

Uniforms are to be turned in after every performance, as per the Auxiliary Uniform Policy

NHS Uniforms/Costumes are not to be worn at any solo contests; these uniforms are owned by the NHS Band and are only for Eagle Pride-Related events. Please refer to the Auxiliary Uniform Policy for further information.
